Here is a little guide w/ dates, costs about sitting for family med board exam.

- 1. Login into ABFM: American Board of Family Medicine
- 2. Check your eligibility
 - --Scroll to the "My Requirements" section and click the "Family Medicine Examination" requirement box
 - --You need completion of a minimum of **50 points** achieved through the following:
- At least one of the following Knowledge Self-Assessment (KSA) activities
 - Knowledge Self-Assessment (KSA)-good to use the Adolescent medicine as one
 of these modules worth 10pts
 - Continuous Knowledge Self-Assessment (CKSA)
- At least one <u>Performance Improvement (PI)</u> activity, this is normally done at continuity clinic HTN module, also called METRIC -worth 20pts
- Additional activities
 - Additional ABFM-developed Knowledge Self-Assessment activities (KSA)- you can do ~25 questions to get 2.5pts/quarter for continued KSA
 - Additional participation with Continuous Knowledge Self -Assessments (CKSA)
 - Approved Alternative Self-Assessment activities
 - Performance Improvement activities (PI)

-You also need at least 150 credits of acceptable <u>Continuing Medical Education</u> (CME) which you all easily have during residency

3. Click the "Begin Online Application" button and proceed as prompted.

Even some residents who have completed all requirements did not have this button/option yet, but I think the link/button will be an option when the April examination app is available, may not be until October 2023
